

Dumbbell Reverse Flye



Description: Stand with feet shoulder width apart. Bend the knees and lean forward maintaining a neutral spine and grasp the dumbbells with your palms facing inward. This is the starting position. Keeping a slight bend at the elbow raise the dumbbells up laterally, squeezing the shoulder blades together. Slowly lower the dumbbells to the starting position and repeat.

Sets/reps: 2-3 sets of 10-12 reps.

Modifications: Momentarily pause at the top of the movement for added intensity.

Common Mistakes: Using momentum to raise the weights, rounding of the back.

Target Muscles: Shoulders, Trapezius, Rhomboids.

****Tip:** When leaning forward, hinge from the hips to avoid rounding the back.
